To enter a dog in working class, the entry form must be accompanied by a copy of the pedigree and a copy of working test certificate.

To enter a dog in Champion Class, one of the following titles must have been confirmed by day of the official closing date of entries, proof of this, by copy, must be enclosed with the entry form. The Club Winner, National Winner, Champion of FCI country, Inter-Champion, Club Winner, Special Show Winner.

### Foreign exhibitors are allowed to pay directly on the place.

# Entries sent after May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019 will be not accepted!!!

#### Classes:

- **1. Baby Class** 4-6 months, in this class the evaluations VP (very promising) or P (Promising) can be achieved
- **2. Puppy Class** 6-9 months, in this class the evaluations VP (very promising) or P (Promising ) can be achieved
- 3. Youth Class 9-18 months, CAJC title can be granted
- 4. Middle Class 15-24 months, CAC (r. CAC) title can be granted
- 5. Open Class above 15 months, CAC (r. CAC) title can be granted
- **6. Working Class**, CAC (r. CAC) title can be granted. To enter a dog in Champion Class, working test certificate must have been confirmed by day of the official closing date of entries.
- **7. Winner's Class** above 15 months, CAC (r. CAC) title can be granted. One of the following titles must have been confirmed by day of the official closing date of entries; proof of this, by copy, must be enclosed with the entry form. International Champion, International Champion of the F.C.I., National Winner, Special Show Winner or Club Show Winner.
- 8. Veteran Class above 8 years
- **9. Honour Class** above 15 months. To enter a dog in Honour Class, one of the following titles must have been confirmed by day of the official closing date of entries; proof of this, by copy, must be enclosed with the entry form. Interchampion, Club Winner, National Winner or Special Show Winner. In this class no CAC title will be granted. Only evaluation and a rank will be set. The dog evaluated with Excellent 1 cannot take part in the final Best of Breed competition.

Dogs or bitches with evaluation VP1, CAJC, CAC and V1 in veteran, honor and outside of competition classes will obtain a cup

Best Baby, Puppy, Club Winner Junior male/female, Club Winner male/female, Veteran. BOB and BOS will obtain a cup and will receive a prize.

#### **Competitions:**

**Best Couple** – a dog and a bitch of the same breed and variety belonging to the same owner who were judged at the show.

**Best Progeny -** father/mother min 5 progeny showing at the show.

**Best Breeding Group** – consisting of minimum three and maximum five exhibits of the same breed and variety, without distinction of sex, bred by the same person (same kennel name), even if they are not his property who were judged at the show **Child and Dog** –Children will be divided depending on their age.

#### **Documents necessary for entering the show:**

Original pedigree, EURO PET Passport

#### **Veterinary conditions:**

The exhibitor declares that any dog entered has been adequately vaccinated (standard vaccinations) of which proof can be shown. The entrant/exhibitor declares further that any dog entered has not knowingly been exposed to any infectious or contagious disease during the twelve weeks prior to the show and that the dog will not be brought to the show should such circumstances arise in the meantime. Dogs coming from abroad are required to have been vaccinated against rabies which must be recorded in a European pet passport.

#### Instructions for filling the entry forms:

The entry forms to be filled only online. Unless Upon check attached document copy of working test certifications or copies confirming the title Club Winner, National Winner, Champion of FCI country of Inter-Champion are missing, the dog will be automatically entered into open class without notifying the owner. Copies will be not returned. The working test certificates for hunting breeds are issued by the respective Kennel Union of the respective country.

One dog can enter one class only. Dogs cannot be moved from one class to another after the closing date. The entry list will be sent via e-mail before the show. The ring statistics will be available after the entry closing date on the Cocker Club CZ webpage <a href="https://www.cockerclub.cz">www.cockerclub.cz</a>.

With acceptance of the entry form the exhibitor is governed by the regulations of FCI show rules and propositions. The exhibitor agrees with presentation of his/her name and address in the Show Catalogue.

#### **General Conditions:**

The show is open for dogs and bitches of the English Cocker Spaniel breed entered into the FCI accepted stood books and they must achieve the respective age necessary for the respective class in which they are entered for.

2<sup>nd</sup> dog means a dog owned by the same owner with the same seat/address.

Imported dogs have to be entered in the Czech stood books, however abbreviations of former stood books and entry number from the former land of an origin must be entered too.

The Show guarantor is not responsible for damages caused by its dog and/or its owner nor for possible lost or death of the dog. The dogs are not allowed to run free. The Show committee can refuse an Entry form without any reason.

Pregnant or sucking bitches, bitches in heat or dog individuals after any veterinary intervention that led to removal of a defect of the respective dog's exterior are suspended from the show

It is forbidden to treat the coat, skin or nose with anything that alters the structure, colour or form. It is strictly forbidden to leave dogs tied up on trimming tables except the time they are prepared for the show (trimmed, brushed or combed).

If not in the proposition stated otherwise, all regulations of International show rules of FCI and show rules of ČMKU are valid.

Only puppies entered for the show are allowed. Sale of puppies on the show is prohibited.

#### Protests:

A protest against the Judge's decision is not acceptable. Raising a protest could be for formal reasons of breakage of show rules and propositions only. The protest must be entered in writing together with a deposit of a security in the amount of CZK 1400,- until the end of the judging in the show rings. If the protest is not accepted, the deposited security will be forfeited in favour of the show organizer.
